SEPTEMBER 18/19: HOME • NICE, FRANCE

Depart your home city on September 18 for an overnight flight to Nice, France. After your plane clears the last of the snowcapped Alps, look for the sun to reflect off the crystal blue waters of the Côte d'Azur. Welcome to the Riviera! You are greeted at the airport and transported to the Intercontinental Carlton Cannes. The afternoon is at your leisure until our welcome reception this evening.

SEPTEMBER 20: CANNES, FRANCE

Golf de Saint Donat. Designed by Robert Trent Jones Jr., Saint Donat is often called a naturalist's golf course with fairways winding through the quiet Provencal landscape. This picturesque layout surrounds a 17th century estate where roses and jasmine bloom near century-old oaks scattered throughout the course. Touring passengers visit Nice and St-Paul-de-Vence. One of the most famous of France's artist villages, St-Paul-de-Vence has a style and charm that is evident in its red-roofed buildings and tiny, winding streets. After a full day of golfing or touring, you will have the evening free to sample the culinary specialties of the French Riviera.

SEPTEMBER 21: MONACO

Monte Carlo Golf Club. Built in 1911, the Monte Carlo Golf Club is considered to be the Côte d'Azur's most prestigious club. Located 900 meters above sea level on Mont Agel, this course features narrow fairways and spectacular views. Touring passengers explore the exciting city of Monte Carlo. We drive by the Prince's palace set high on the hill of Monaco Rock as well as the neo-Romanesque cathedral where Princess Grace and Prince Rainier were married. After lunch we tour the Casino, then board *Sea Cloud II*.

SEPTEMBER 22: ST-RAPHAËL, FRANCE

Golf de Terre Blanche - Le Château. Tucked away in the southeastern corner of Provence are two Dave Thomas designed courses—Le Château and Le Riou, which comprise the Four Seasons Golf Club. Le Château winds its way through pine and oak forests and up to elevated tees where views of French villages and the rocky peaks of the Alpes Maritimes await. The course presents both technical challenges and charm with holes like number six where the green sits in the shadow of the course's namesake—Le Château. Touring passengers enjoy a Full-Day Spa Program at The Four Seasons Provence, ranked among the top spa facilities in Europe. Guests receive the royal treatment in this jaw-dropping grand spa nestled in the heart of lavender-scented Provencal countryside.

SEPTEMBER 23: DAY AT SEA

No matter what region of the world we are in or how many times you have been on board *Sea Cloud II*, our day at sea is always a favorite among Kalos travelers. Sit back and watch skilled deckhands scale the rigging and set the sails for our voyage. *Sea Cloud II*'s captain will plan the course to take full advantage of the prevailing winds, allowing you to enjoy the ideal pace of travel. The sun-soaked Lido Deck provides a perfect setting for the day.

SEPTEMBER 24: ORBETELLO, ITALY

Argentario Golf Club. Situated in an oasis on the edge of Tuscany, *Argentario Golf Club* offers an excellent layout surrounded by cork forests, hundred-year-old olive trees and extraordinary Mediterranean scenery. Accuracy on the approach is key to scoring well on these well-protected, small greens. Those joining the tour will meet Antonio Guida, Chef of *Il Pellicano*, a one-star Michelin restaurant ideally situated overlooking the unspoiled waters of the Tuscan coast. In addition

to learning how to make fresh pasta and risotto, we sample the best extra virgin olive oils and gain a better appreciation of the famous Tuscan red wines.

SEPTEMBER 25: BONIFACIO, CORSICA

Golf de Sperone. Described by many as Robert Trent Jones Sr.'s "Jewel in the Mediterranean," *Golf de Sperone* is well established as one of Europe's finest courses. The 16th hole may be the most memorable. Similar to the 18th at *Pebble Beach*, this hole is framed by 100 ft. sea-cliffs on one side. Those on tour visit the medieval city of Bonifacio. The town rises dramatically in tiers from the old port up to the Genovese citadel. The fortifications dominate the fjord and the dramatic limestone peninsula that rises on sheer cliffs out of the sea.

SEPTEMBER 26: COSTA SMERALDA, SARDINIA

Pevero Golf Club. Eight miles to the south of Bonifacio, *Sea Cloud II* anchors off the white beaches of the bay of Pevero. Designed by Robert Trent Jones Sr., *Pevero Golf Club*'s greens and fairways wind through the Sardinian hills among natural lakes and rock formations. The doglegs and water hazards will test any golfer's accuracy. Touring passengers travel north to explore the islands of the tranquil and serene Maddalena Archipelago. Passengers are treated to stunning views during the scenic drive on Maddalena Archipelago, and to a tasty local lunch.

SEPTEMBER 27: COSTA SMERALDA, SARDINIA

Pevero Golf Club. Golfers will enjoy another opportunity to play *Pevero Golf Club*. Touring passengers trace the path of the Aga Khan on a guided tour of Costa Smeralda, learning what led to the 1960s development of this beautiful natural environment. Surrounded by emerald green water, beautiful bays, granite rock and mountains, this coastal resort area is filled with posh hotels, shops, yacht marinas and villas that blend harmoniously into the landscape.
