

ITINERARY • 11 DAYS

SEPTEMBER 17/18: HOME • NICE, FRANCE

Depart your home city on September 17 for an overnight flight to Nice, France. After your plane clears the last of the snowcapped Alps, look for the sun to reflect off the crystal blue waters of the Côte d'Azur. Welcome to the Riviera! You are greeted at the airport and transported to the five-star Hotel Majestic in Cannes. The afternoon is at your leisure until our welcome reception this evening.

SEPTEMBER 19: CANNES, FRANCE

Golf de Terre Blanche - Le Château. Tucked away in the southeastern corner of Provence is a Dave Thomas designed course—Le Château. The course winds its

way through pine and oak forests and up to elevated tees where views of French villages and the rocky peaks of the Alpes Maritimes await. The course presents both technical challenges and charm with holes like number six where the green sits in the shadow of the course's namesake—Le Château. Touring passengers visit

Nice and St-Paul-de-Vence. One of the most famous of France's artist villages, St-Paul-de-Vence has a style and charm that is evident in its red-roofed buildings and tiny, winding streets. After a full day of golfing or touring, you will have the evening free to sample the culinary specialties of the French Riviera.

SEPTEMBER 20: MONACO

Monte Carlo Golf Club. Built in 1911, the Monte Carlo Golf Club is considered to be the Côte d'Azur's most prestigious club. Located 900 meters above sea level on Mont Agel, this course features narrow fairways and spectacular views. Touring passengers explore the exciting city of Monte Carlo. We drive by the Prince's palace set high on the hill of Monaco Rock as well as the neo-Romanesque cathedral where Princess Grace and Prince Rainier were married. After lunch we tour the Casino, then board *Sea Cloud II*.

SEPTEMBER 21: ST-TROPEZ, FRANCE

Gassin Golf & Country Club. The opening of Gassin Golf Club in 2004 gave golfers another reason to visit St-Tropez. This Gary Player design is nestled within a protected environmental area and offers stunning views of the peninsula's four villages: Grimaud, Gassin, Ramatuelle and St-Tropez. Touring passengers have time to experience St-Tropez, "The Pearl of the Riviera," best known as a destination for the glamorous and illustrious. Its allure is undeniable, having captured the likes of Matisse and Bardot.

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SEPTEMBER 22: DAY AT SEA

No matter what region of the world we are in or how many times you have been on board *Sea Cloud II*, our day at sea is always a favorite among Kalos travelers. Sit back and watch skilled deckhands scale the rigging and set the sails for our voyage. *Sea Cloud II's* captain will plan the course to take full advantage of the prevailing winds, allowing you to enjoy the ideal pace of travel. The sun-soaked Lido Deck provides a perfect setting for the day.

SEPTEMBER 23: MONTALCINO, ITALY

A special highlight of our Riviera Golf Cruise, today's tour into the Tuscan countryside gives all passengers the opportunity to visit the town of Montalcino and its famous Brunello vineyards. Set on a hilltop, the medieval walls of Montalcino overlook the vineyards, where we venture for an exclusive tour and tastings. Loosely translated in the local dialect as "nice dark one," Brunello dates to the early 14th century and has a long reputation as one of Italy's rarest and finest wines, due in large part to the warm and dry Tuscan climate and mandatory use of the Sangiovese grape.

SEPTEMBER 24: COSTA SMERALDA, SARDINIA
Pevero Golf Club. Designed by Robert Trent Jones Sr., Pevero Golf Club's greens and fairways wind through the Sardinian hills among natural lakes and rock formations. The doglegs and water hazards will test any golfer's accuracy. Touring passengers travel north to explore the islands of the tranquil and serene Maddalena Archipelago. Passengers are treated to stunning views during the scenic drive on Maddalena Archipelago, and to a tasty local lunch.

SEPTEMBER 25: COSTA SMERALDA, SARDINIA
Pevero Golf Club. Golfers will enjoy another opportunity to play Pevero Golf Club. Touring passengers trace the path of the Aga Khan on a guided tour of Costa Smeralda, learning what led to the 1960s development of this beautiful natural environment. Surrounded by emerald green water, beautiful bays, granite rock and mountains, this coastal resort area is filled with posh hotels, shops, yacht marinas and villas that blend harmoniously into the landscape.

SEPTEMBER 26: BONIFACIO, CORSICA

Golf de Sperone. Described by many as Robert Trent Jones Sr.'s "Jewel in the Mediterranean," *Golf de Sperone* is well established as one of Europe's finest courses. The 16th hole may be the most memorable. Similar to the 18th at Pebble Beach, this hole is framed by 100 ft. sea-cliffs on one side.

Those on tour visit the medieval city of Bonifacio. The town rises dramatically in tiers from the old port up to the Genovese citadel. The fortifications dominate the fjord and the dramatic limestone peninsula that rises on sheer cliffs out of the sea.

SEPTEMBER 27: ROME, ITALY • HOME

We bid farewell to *Sea Cloud II* in the port city of Civitavecchia and begin transfers for homebound flights. Many travelers may wish to extend their stay in Rome or join us on a short flight to Milan where the extension tour stays at one of Europe's finest resorts, Villa d' Este on Lake Como.

Lake Como Extension Tour September 27-30, 2011



Grand Hotel Villa d'Este

This three-day tour takes us to Lake Como, Italy's premier resort location. Accommodations are at Villa d'Este, once a 16th century private estate located in a ten-acre private park bordering Lake Como.

Golfers play Villa d'Este Golf Club, considered to be one of Italy's best courses. Villa d'Este Golf Club has long been a favorite among golfers from around the world. Designed by English architect Peter Gannon, this course has hosted twelve Italian Opens.

Extension participants also enjoy a private lake cruise where they leisurely pass by the mansions, gardens, and charming villages, including Bellagio, that lie on Lake Como's shores. Some guests may

choose to explore Milan or Lake Lugano in nearby Switzerland independently, but many will enjoy the host of activities available at Villa d'Este.

Tour price is \$2,975 per person, double occupancy (\$3,465 per person for Junior Suite), and is limited to a maximum of 24 guests. The price includes three nights at Villa d'Este, breakfasts, lake cruise, greens fee, transfers for one round of golf, and airport transfers. Airfare from Rome to Milan is not included but will be arranged by Kalos Golf.
