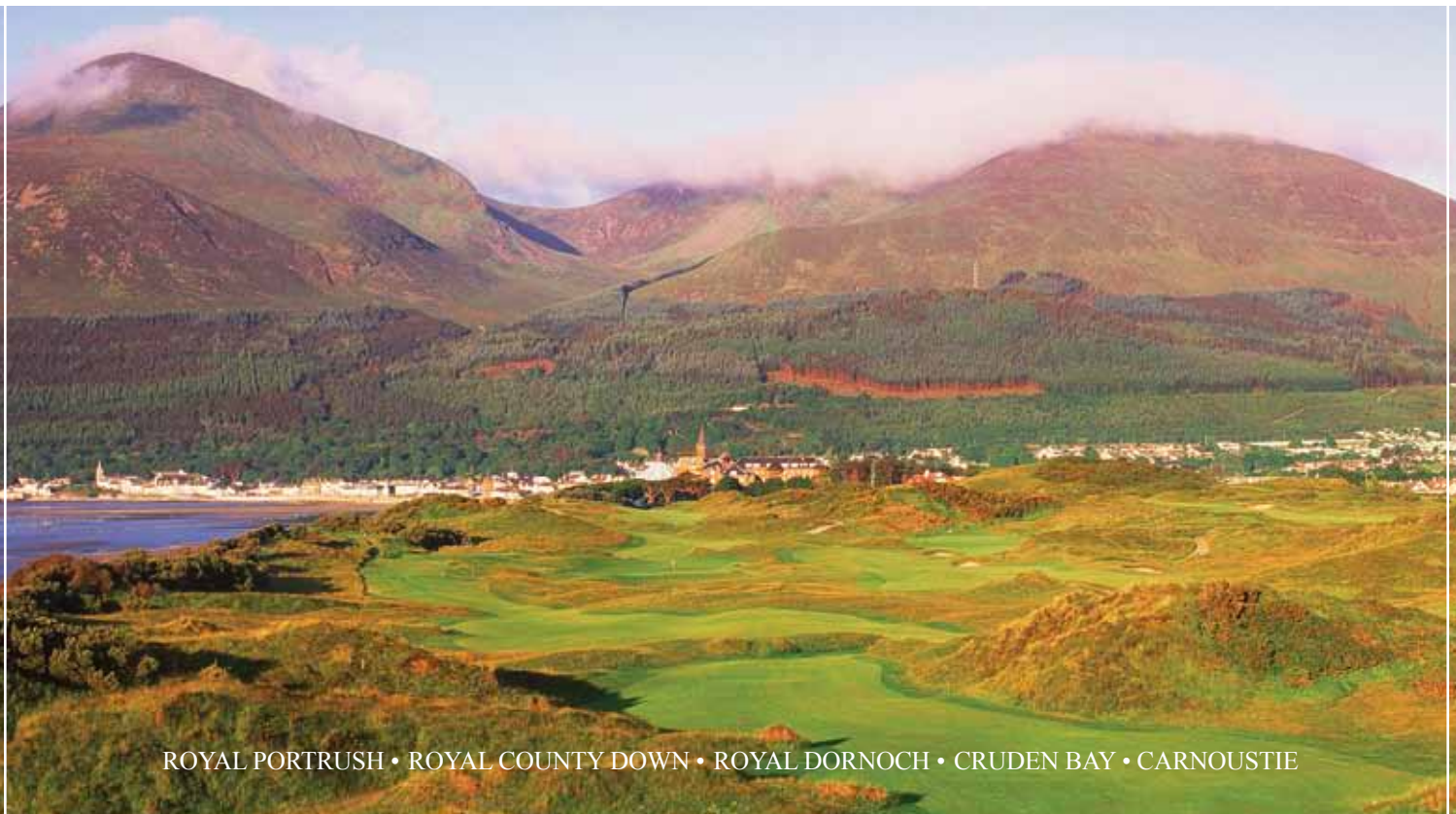

## ITINERARY • 9 DAYS

### AUGUST 7/8: HOME • DUBLIN, IRELAND

Depart your home city on August 7 for an overnight flight to Dublin, Ireland. Upon arrival, you are greeted at the airport before your transfer to the *Clipper Odyssey*.

### AUGUST 9: PORTRUSH, NORTHERN IRELAND

**GOLF:** ROYAL PORTRUSH GOLF CLUB

Designed by H. S. Colt, the Dunluce Links at Royal Portrush Golf Club is the only course outside of Scotland, England and Wales to host the British Open. Harry Colt considered the course to be his masterpiece and not a single hole fails to impress. Calamity Corner, the 14<sup>th</sup> hole, is recognized as one of the world's most treacherous par threes, with its green perched on the edge of a precipice. Rarely has there been such a successful collaboration between man and nature.

**TOUR:** GIANT'S CAUSEWAY AND DUNLUCE CASTLE

Those on tour visit two marvels of the Antrim Coast. Our first stop is at the Giant's Causeway, a natural rock formation often referred to as the eighth wonder of the world. Further down the road lies Dunluce Castle, precariously situated on a cliff overlooking the sea. Lunch is a fine sampling of local cuisine at The Bushmills Inn.

### AUGUST 10: BELFAST, NORTHERN IRELAND

**GOLF:** ROYAL COUNTY DOWN

Designed by Old Tom Morris, Royal County Down is admired as one of the most beautiful golf courses in the world and is consistently ranked among the world's top five. Laid out through giant sandhills along a narrow strip of land between Dundrum Bay and the Mourne Mountains, Royal County Down offers spellbinding scenery and a fine test of golf.

**TOUR:** BELFAST

Famous for its political and seafaring history, this capital city of Northern Ireland is fast becoming one of Europe's favored destinations. Touring passengers will explore the Cathedral Quarter and the Golden Mile, stretching from City Hall to Queen's University. Also steeped in literary tradition, Belfast is flanked by a series of scenic hills that were the inspiration for "Gulliver's Travels" by Jonathan Swift.

### AUGUST 11: DAY AT SEA

### AUGUST 12: INVERGORDON, SCOTLAND

**GOLF:** ROYAL DORNOCH GOLF CLUB

The remoteness of Royal Dornoch has helped create a mystique about this magnificent golf outpost, just four degrees below the Arctic Circle. Overlooking the North Sea, Dornoch is characterized by gentle sandy swells and rolls. Considered a brilliant example of links design, it is often ranked 15<sup>th</sup> among the world's top 100 courses. Renowned golf course architect Donald Ross, who was born in Dornoch, caddied at the club as a youngster and later spent six years as greenskeeper and golf professional at Dornoch.

**TOUR:** VILLAGE OF DORNOCH AND DUNROBIN CASTLE

Those on tour have the opportunity to visit the unspoiled Edwardian town of Dornoch. Our visit includes the small and charming Dornoch Cathedral, which dates back to 1224. We also tour the famous Dunrobin Castle where we attend a demonstration of the noble art of falconry.

### AUGUST 13: PETERHEAD, SCOTLAND

**GOLF:** CRUDEN BAY

This course is frequently referred to as the most dramatic golf links in Scotland. Cruden Bay's natural routing combined with its stunning setting and landscape invites golfers to return again and again. You don't have to be a long hitter to enjoy Cruden Bay. The key to a great round is in your approach to the imaginatively positioned greens.

**TOUR:** ABERDEEN & CRATHES CASTLE

From Cruden Bay, our tour heads to Royal Deeside. Here we visit Crathes Castle, one of the finest examples of a 16<sup>th</sup> century tower house in all of Scotland. The castle's impressive interior is matched by the lovely walled gardens that surround it.

### AUGUST 14: DUNDEE, SCOTLAND

This morning we say goodbye to the captain and crew of *Clipper Odyssey*. Following the day's golf or touring, we transfer to St Andrews where we overnight at The Old Course Hotel alongside the famous 17<sup>th</sup> hole.

**GOLF:** CARNOUSTIE GOLF LINKS

The game of golf has been played at Carnoustie for more than four centuries. Tom Morris extended the course to 18 holes in 1867, but it was James Braid who brought sweeping changes to the course in preparation for its first Open Championship in 1931. Hogan's Alley, the Spectacles bunkers and the 17<sup>th</sup> hole, with its Barry Burn, all make the "Angus Monster" one of the world's most memorable courses.

**TOUR:** SCONE PALACE AND TOWN OF ST ANDREWS

We visit Scone Palace, a splendid castle whose grounds include the ruins of the historic village of Scone. This spot has been the capital of the Pictish kingdom, the center of the ancient Celtic church, the seat of parliaments and the crowning place of kings. We also take a guided walking tour to view the highlights of St Andrews, including its prestigious university and 12<sup>th</sup> century cathedral.

**AUGUST 15: EDINBURGH, SCOTLAND • HOME**

This morning we depart The Old Course Hotel and transfer to Edinburgh Airport for homebound flights, or you may wish to join the St Andrews Extension Tour.



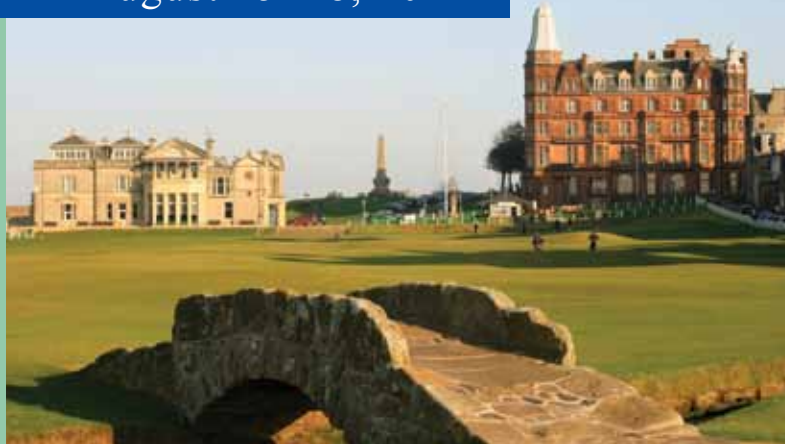

Those who wish to extend their trip to play The Old Course can join our St Andrews Extension Tour. Participants continue their stay at The Old Course Hotel, overlooking the 17<sup>th</sup> “Road Hole,” with easy access to the town of St Andrews and all the challenging golf that surrounds it.

This package includes three rounds of golf at:

**JUBILEE OR THE NEW COURSE:** Both challenging links courses nestled between the sea and The Old Course, they are often overshadowed by their more famous neighbor, yet these courses offer a great test of golf.

**KINGSBARNs:** The most scenic of the courses in St Andrews, this was one of the youngest courses to be ranked among the world’s top 100.

**THE OLD COURSE:** Host to 28 British Opens and considered by many to be the “Home of Golf,” The Old Course is on every golfer’s bucket list. The most memorable shot in golf is when you tee it up in front of the Royal & Ancient.

Prices start at £1,975 per golfer.

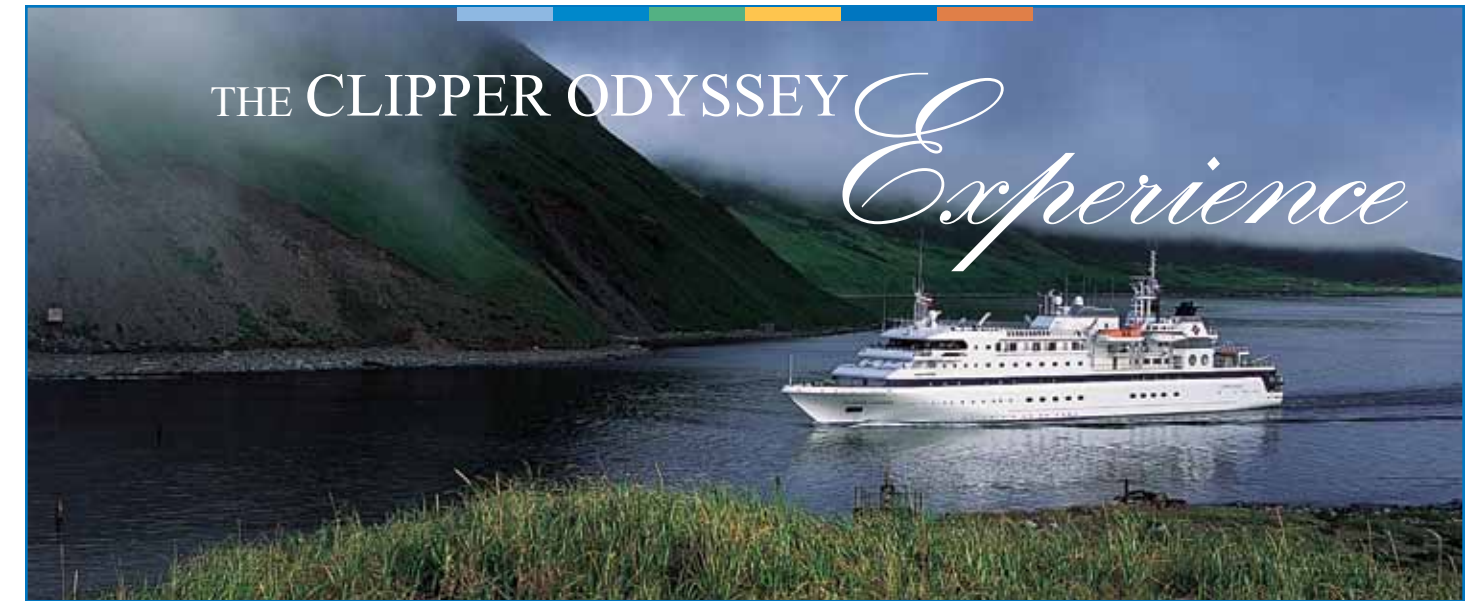

**Turnberry Extension Tour • August 15–17, 2012**

The Turnberry Extension Tour will also be available from August 18–20 as an option for those participating in the St Andrews Extension Tour.
