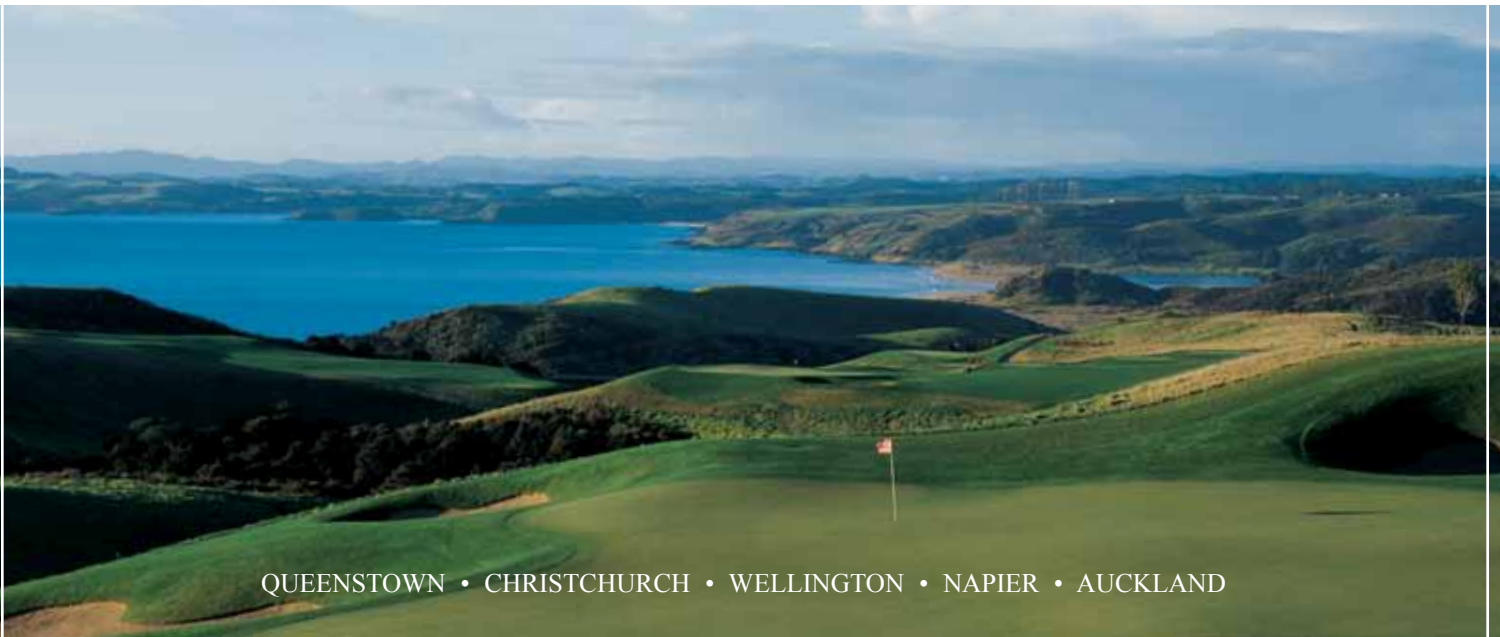

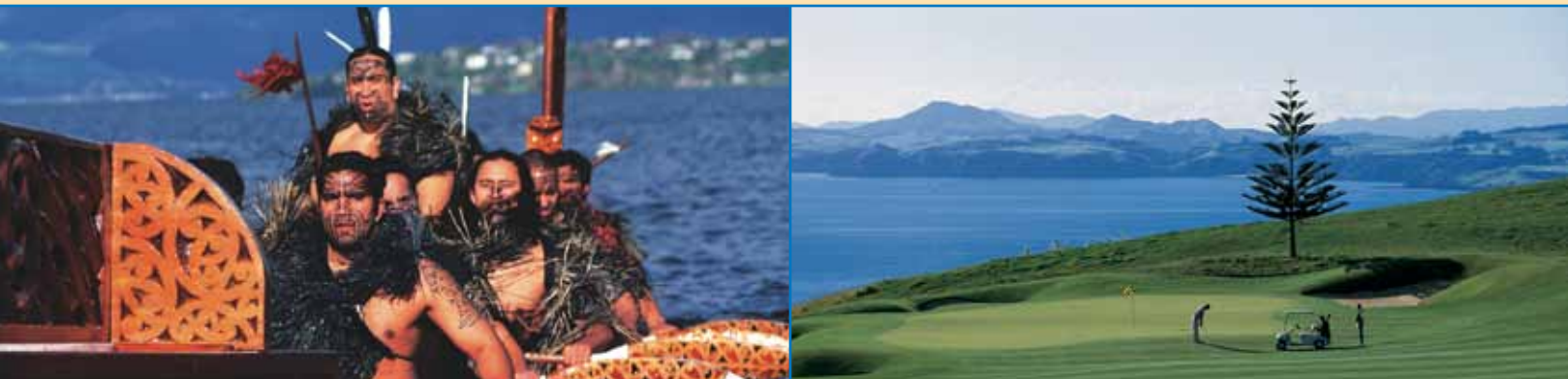
NEW ZEALAND IS A LAND OF EXTRAORDINARY CONTRASTS AND BEAUTY.

Jack's Point

TOUR: AMISFIELD WINERY & ARROWTOWN

While Queenstown is known as the "Adventure Capital of the World," it is also one of the fastest growing wine regions in the country. Our Kiwi wine expert is on hand to explain the details of the wine making process while we sample the region's Pinot Noirs, ranked among the world's finest. After lunch, we visit Arrowtown, New Zealand's only living, historic gold rush town.

FEBRUARY 15: QUEENSTOWN (SOUTH ISLAND)

GOLF: THE HILLS

Home to three New Zealand Opens and the most private course in New Zealand, The Hills sits on a magnificent site surrounded by The Remarkables mountains. Holes are strategically placed amongst the native flora and wetland areas, creating a true championship course.

TOUR: JET BOAT ADVENTURE

We embark on a scenic jet boat experience—an exhilarating ride on Lake Wakatipu and the spectacular Shotover River.

FEBRUARY 11: DEPART HOME

Depart home for an overnight flight to Queenstown, New Zealand.

FEBRUARY 12: CROSS INTERNATIONAL DATE LINE

Day lost crossing the International Date Line.

FEBRUARY 13: QUEENSTOWN (SOUTH ISLAND)

Upon arrival in Queenstown, New Zealand, you are transferred to the Sofitel Queenstown Hotel and Spa where your hotel room awaits you. Relax and explore this delightful town until our welcome reception this evening.

FEBRUARY 14: QUEENSTOWN (SOUTH ISLAND)

GOLF: JACK'S POINT

Set within a 3,000-acre nature preserve, Jack's Point is the newest addition to Queenstown golf. The course's elevation changes offer sweeping lake and alpine vistas with a 360-degree mountainscape. Winds off Lake Wakatipu will challenge golfers and provide a fitting start to golf on the South Island.

FEBRUARY 16: CHRISTCHURCH (SOUTH ISLAND)

• **EMBARK ORION**

TOUR: CHRISTCHURCH

This morning we fly to Christchurch, located on the Canterbury Plains which are renowned for their sheep farms. We enjoy a private visit to the family-owned Flaxton Farm. We meet the owners, tour the historic farmhouse, watch sheep shearing and observe the talented sheep dogs. Later in the afternoon, we board *Orion* to begin our voyage.

FEBRUARY 17: WELLINGTON (NORTH ISLAND)

GOLF: ROYAL WELLINGTON GOLF CLUB

Established in 1895, Royal Wellington Golf Club is the only golf club in New Zealand with a royal designation. The course derives its unique character from a rich diversity of trees, abundant bird life and meandering streams that come into play on many holes. The tranquil splendor of this flat parkland course is quite inviting. Accuracy off the tee instead of length will ensure a good round.

TOUR: WELLINGTON

Today we explore New Zealand's sophisticated capital city, Wellington, where colorful Victorian houses grace the steep hills surrounding one of the prettiest harbors in the southern hemisphere. We head to the summit of Mount Victoria for a 360-degree view of the city, then visit Te Papa, the national museum of New Zealand, filled with highly creative exhibits, bringing the stories, art and culture of the New Zealand people to life. There is time in the afternoon to browse the many shops and cafés that surround the waterfront.

FEBRUARY 18: DAY AT SEA

Delight in a full day at sea on *Orion*. Sit back and relax or take advantage of the oceanview fitness room, sauna and whirlpool. Our lectures will enlighten us about New Zealand flora and fauna as we take in the natural scenery aboard *Orion*.

FEBRUARY 19: NAPIER (NORTH ISLAND)

GOLF: CAPE KIDNAPPERS

A compelling course on a dramatic site makes Cape Kidnappers one of the highlights of our cruise. Tom Doak created this prize-winning golf course on land perched 500 feet above Hawke's Bay—a site that "belongs more to heaven than earth." Doak's brilliant design is best demonstrated by just how naturally many fairways utilize the most scenic parts of the site and yet remain fully playable. Generous fairways give way to challenging approach shots into complex greens.

TOUR: GANNET COLONY & NAPIER

Our morning begins with a trip to the extraordinary Cape Kidnappers gannet colony—the only place in the world to see up close the nesting place of over 20,000 gannets. As we watch these birds fly off the cliffs to dive deep for fish, our local guides explain the preening, dance performances and behaviors we witness. This afternoon there is time to explore Napier and its famed Art Deco architecture. Rebuilt after a devastating earthquake, Napier offers the greatest variety and concentration of 1930s building styles in existence—Stripped Classical, Spanish Mission and, above all, Art Deco.

FEBRUARY 20: NAPIER (NORTH ISLAND)

GOLF: CAPE KIDNAPPERS

Golfers will relish a second round at Cape Kidnappers. No excuses about the prevailing winds today on the par three 6th, a cliff-to-cliff shot, or on the par five 15th hole, otherwise known as "Pirates Plank," which edges out to a green that hangs 450 feet above the Pacific.

TOUR: THE WINES OF HAWKE'S BAY

Hawke's Bay, the oldest established winegrowing region in New Zealand, is home to many of the country's most famous vineyards. Today, we explore the region's fine wines with tastings led by award-winning vintners. Our enjoyable final tasting is paired with local specialties for lunch.

FEBRUARY 21: DAY AT SEA

All passengers will take pleasure in another day at sea as we relax and enjoy the comforts *Orion* provides while cruising these beautiful waters past dramatic coastlines and pristine islands. This afternoon our onboard lecturers discuss the history that unfolded as European sailors explored this region.

FEBRUARY 22: BAY OF ISLANDS (NORTH ISLAND)

GOLF: KAURI CLIFFS

In 2000, American Julian Robertson created this golf course gem, which catapulted into the world's top 50 just one year after completion. The dazzling sea views at every turn and a series of surprising par threes vie for your attention. Where Cape Kidnappers is demanding in approaching the greens, Kauri Cliffs is demanding off the tee. The backside is the more dramatic with six holes hugging the cliffs.

TOUR: KIWI CULINARY EXPERIENCE

Today we enjoy a unique cooking workshop in which we learn how to prepare New Zealand cuisine. The dishes demonstrated will be served during a gourmet lunch paired with fine Northland wines.

FEBRUARY 23: BAY OF ISLANDS (NORTH ISLAND)

GOLF: KAURI CLIFFS

Golfers will savor a second chance to master this scenic layout, and Kauri Cliffs is up to the challenge. Approach shots will be better measured but new hole locations present plenty of new strategy.

TOUR: WAITANGI TREATY GROUNDS & RUSSELL

We visit New Zealand's paramount historic site, the Waitangi Treaty Grounds. Then we board a water taxi to the quaint village of Russell, the first capital of New Zealand.

FEBRUARY 24: AUCKLAND (NORTH ISLAND) • DISEMBARK ORION • HOME

We bid farewell to the captain and his crew as we begin transfers for homebound flights or you may extend your stay and travel on to Melbourne, Australia.

**MELBOURNE EXTENSION TOUR
FEBRUARY 24–27, 2013**

Fly to Melbourne, Australia, and transfer to the five-star Park Hyatt Hotel—ideally located in Parliament Square—where you will spend three nights. Play the Alister Mackenzie designed Royal Melbourne Golf Club, consistently ranked among the top 20 golf courses in the world. There is ample time to tour city sites, the scenic vineyards of the Yarra Valley and Healesville Sanctuary where kangaroos, koalas and other Australian wildlife can be seen in their natural habitat.



The Melbourne tour price is \$2,985 per person, double occupancy, and includes: three nights accommodations, breakfasts, one round of golf, tours and airport transfers. Airfare from New Zealand to Australia is not included but will be arranged by Kalos Golf. Handicap restrictions apply.

**TASMANIA GOLF EXTENSION TOUR
FEBRUARY 27–MARCH 1, 2013**

After a short flight to Tasmania, Australia, we drive to Barnbougle Dunes where we will spend two nights at Lost Farm Lodge, beautifully perched overlooking the ocean. Play both the Tom Doak designed Links course, currently ranked 35th in the world, as well as the newly created Coore & Crenshaw Lost Farm course, already receiving rave reviews. Tasmania's tranquil setting provides the perfect backdrop for golf.



The Tasmania tour price is \$1,265 per person, double occupancy, and includes: two nights accommodations, breakfasts, two rounds of golf and airport transfers. Airfare from Melbourne to Tasmania is not included but will be arranged by Kalos Golf.

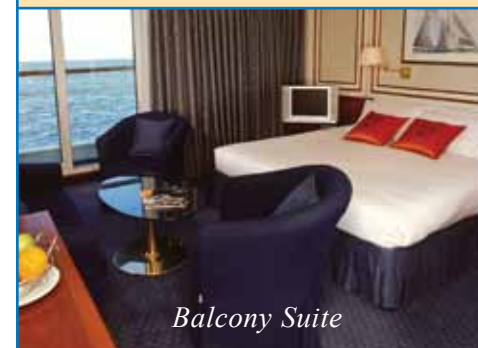
Onboard amenities include a health spa, fitness room, sauna, whirlpool, library, theater, boutique and hair salon.



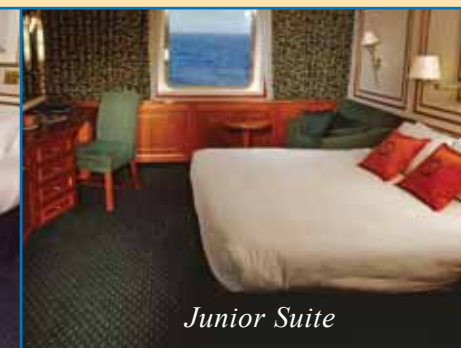
