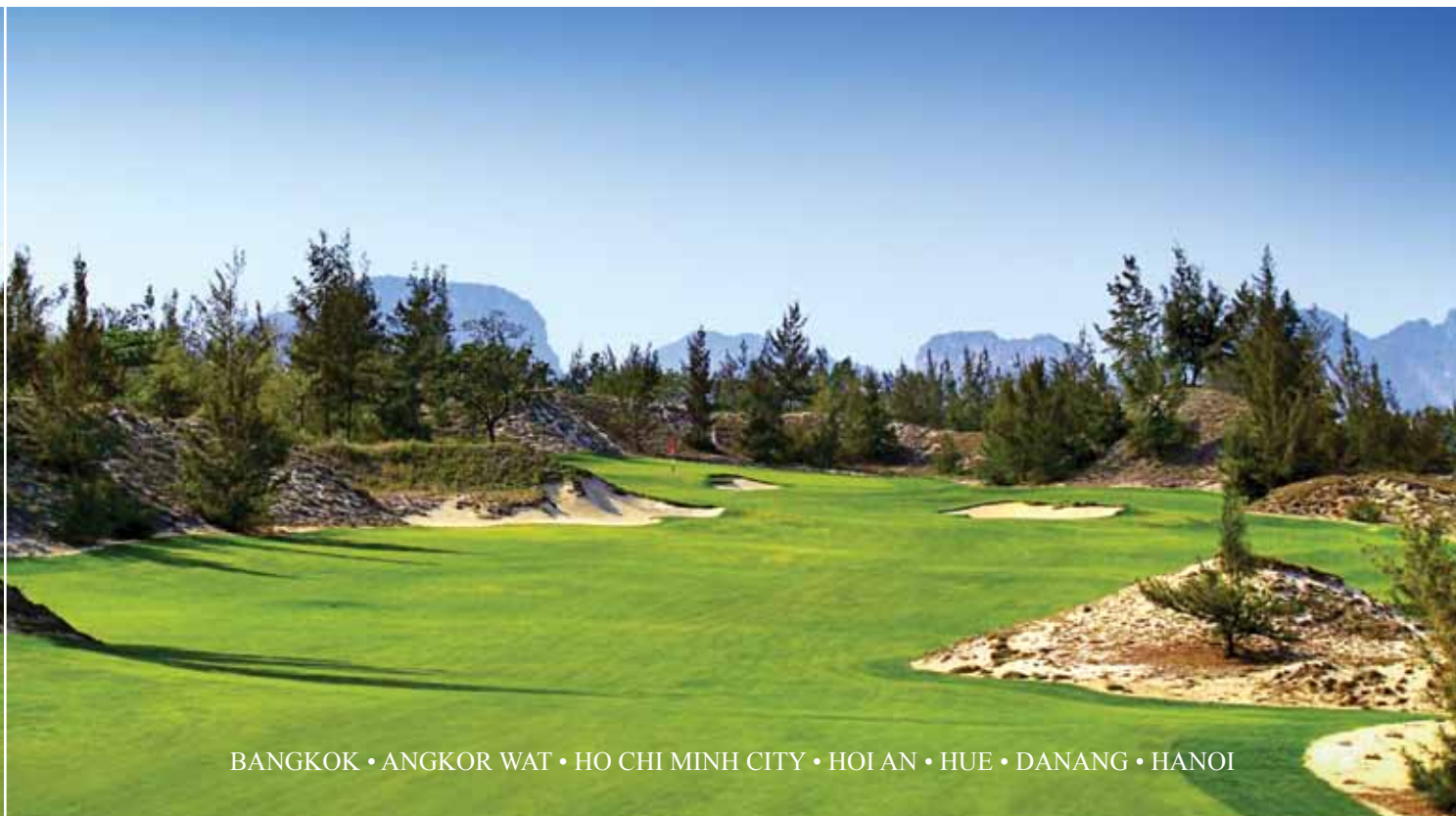

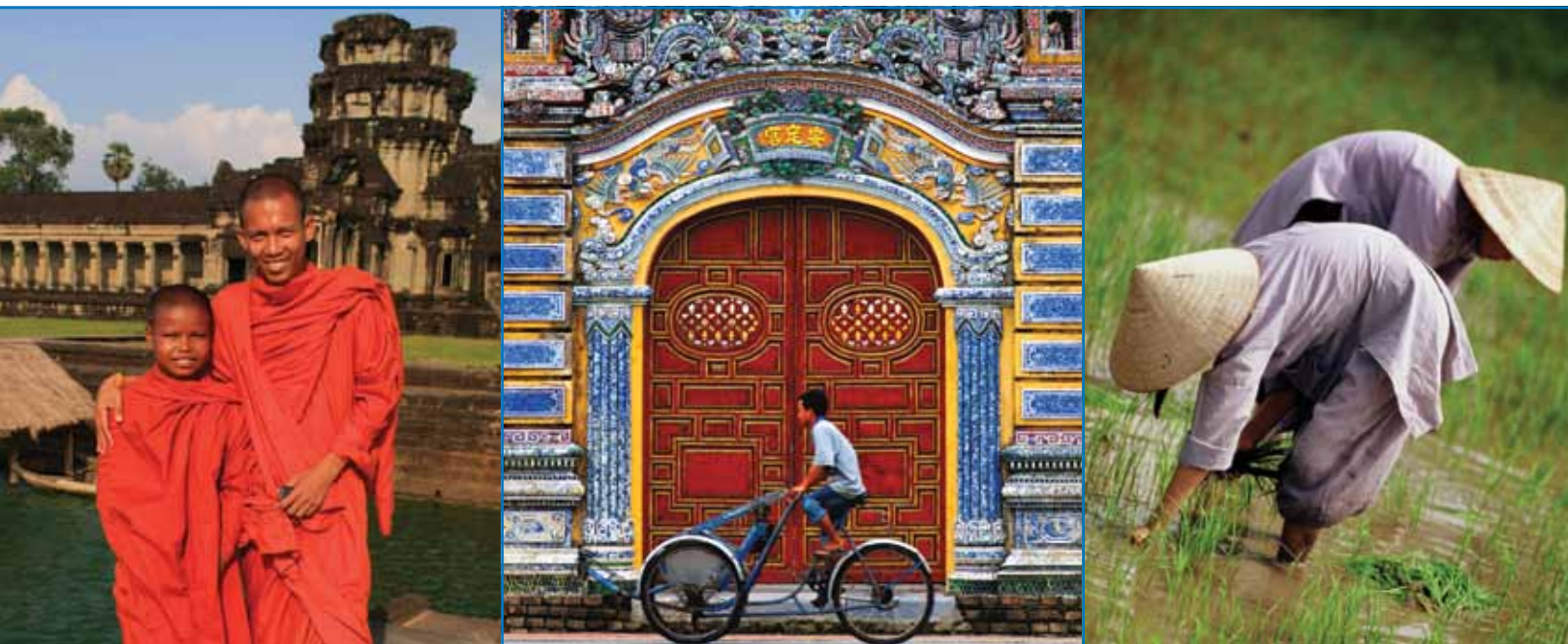

**JANUARY 20: SIEM REAP, CAMBODIA**

**GOLF: ANGKOR GOLF RESORT**

Angkor Golf Resort is the finest golf course in Cambodia, a magnificent 72 par designed by Nick Faldo and opened in 2007. Faldo's design offers generous fairways with bold bunkering. The greens have subtle undulations that encourage a variety of approach shots. Golfers will tour Angkor Wat after their round of golf.

**TOUR: ANGKOR WAT**

Today we tour the awe-inspiring Angkor complex, ancient capital of Cambodia and one of the best sights in Southeast Asia. Built in the early 12<sup>th</sup> century in the classical Khmer architectural style, the Angkor Wat temple is the largest in the world, with a volume of stone equal to that of the Great Pyramid in Egypt.

**JANUARY 19: SIEM REAP, CAMBODIA**

Upon arrival at Siem Reap Airport you are transferred to the Hotel Sofitel Angkor Phokeethra in the heart of Cambodia's ancient capital. Relax and explore the area until our welcome reception this evening.

**JANUARY 21: SIEM REAP, CAMBODIA**

**GOLF: PHOKEETHRA COUNTRY CLUB**

Phokeethra Country Club features water on all but one hole, with the 18<sup>th</sup> hole requiring golfers to carry the water twice before approaching a challenging island green.

*TOUR: BANTEAY SREI*

Considered by some to be the most beautiful temple due to its elaborate pink sandstone carvings, Banteay Srei is an interesting contrast in style from the structures of the main Angkor complex. Our tour includes an ox-cart ride alongside rice paddies and a special lunch of Khmer cuisine served in a local home.

**JANUARY 22: HO CHI MINH CITY, VIETNAM • EMBARK CLIPPER ODYSSEY**

*TOUR: SAIGON OR CU CHI TUNNELS*

Our short morning flight to Ho Chi Minh City, Vietnam, leaves us ample time for exploring before we board *Clipper Odyssey* in the afternoon. The most Western of Vietnam's cities, the former Saigon is a bustling city with a booming freemarket economy. Passengers have the opportunity to explore the quieter streets of Old Saigon, with tree-lined lanes that maintain their French colonial architecture and charm. Alternatively, we go outside of Saigon to tour the Cu Chi Tunnels, a vast underground network used by Vietnamese guerillas. Visitors are astonished by the intricacy of the tunnels, which include living areas, kitchens and triage rooms.

**JANUARY 23: PHAN THIET, VIETNAM**

*GOLF: OCEAN DUNES GOLF CLUB*

Today's round of golf is at Ocean Dunes, a Nick Faldo design combining sand dunes, coastal breezes, beach vegetation and sea views to create a fantastic variety of holes and an array of strategic decisions. The natural features dictated the character and routing of the course, with a tree-lined stretch on the back nine reminiscent of Pinehurst.

*TOUR: PHAN THIET & MUI NE BEACH*

Home to a picture-perfect armada of fishing boats, Phan Thiet offers touring passengers a glimpse of coastal village living in Vietnam. Watch the men deliver the day's catch by coracle while the women shuck shellfish and mend nets right on the beach. Via Jeep ride, we also explore Mui Ne Beach and its amazing Red Dunes, described as a "beachside Sahara."

**JANUARY 24: DAY AT SEA**

Delight in a full day at sea aboard *Clipper Odyssey* as we cruise along the central coast of Vietnam and witness the natural beauty of this country. Relax on the deck or take advantage of the fitness room. Our lectures focus on Vietnam's history and how political leaders are managing the explosive growth.

**JANUARY 25: DANANG, VIETNAM**

*GOLF: MONTGOMERIE LINKS*

Colin Montgomerie was the first course designer to break ground in the famed Central Coast, which is the hotbed for golf in Vietnam. With the Marble Mountains as a backdrop, the course offers an exciting mixture of heathland and modern links-style holes that cater to players of all abilities. Golfers will have an opportunity to explore Hoi An after their round of golf.

**JANUARY 26: DANANG, VIETNAM**

*GOLF: DANANG GOLF CLUB*

The championship Dunes course at Danang Golf Resort, designed by Greg Norman, opened in 2010 to critical acclaim. Danang Golf Club annually vies with Montgomerie Links to be named #1 in Vietnam. The natural terrain and sand dunes are reminiscent of many Scottish courses, and the signature 16<sup>th</sup> hole is nestled into the dunes overlooking China Beach.

We take a short bicycle tour through the village of Cam Thanh and its neighboring rice fields to see Vietnam's rural culture in action. Riding alongside schoolchildren, farmers and fishermen provides us with an interactive view of everyday life.

**JANUARY 27: CHAN MAY, VIETNAM**

*TOUR: HUE*

All passengers have the opportunity to visit Hue, the old imperial capital of Vietnam. Dotted with hundreds of temples, pagodas, palaces and intricate stone sculptures, Hue's captivating history unfolds as we visit the Royal Citadel, with its towering ramparts, and the Forbidden Purple City, once the exclusive inner domain of the emperors.

*TOUR: HOI AN AND RED BRIDGE COOKING SCHOOL*

Our short drive from Danang along China Beach takes us to the ancient city of Hoi An, where merchants from around the world have met for centuries to trade their goods. Their multi-cultural influence is apparent in Hoi An's architecture, including the Japanese Bridge, built in 1593 to connect the town's Japanese and Chinese communities. Chefs from Red Bridge Restaurant accompany our group through the Hoi An market, helping to select and purchase fresh ingredients. We then travel up river to the restaurant where we learn about Vietnamese cuisine in a hands-on cooking class, as featured in *The New York Times*. We conclude with a delicious lunch at its beautiful waterfront location.

### GOLF: VAN TRI GOLF CLUB

Vietnam's first private golf club—and Hanoi's most prestigious—hosts our final round of golf. Van Tri's naturally shaped contours will present golfers with a variety of challenges, including multiple lines of play, forced carries and strategically placed hazards. The unique design and private atmosphere of the clubhouse offers a welcome retreat as we gather for drinks after our last round.

### TOUR: HANOI OLD QUARTER

After transferring from the *Clipper Odyssey* to Hanoi, touring passengers are treated to a fascinating trip through 36 Streets District, the city's main shopping area. Goods were once traded here under the street name of a particular guild, so themes remain, such as Sugar Street, Tin Street and Paper Street. We have a local lunch in the nearby Hoan Kiem district before arriving at the five-star Sofitel Metropole Hotel.

## JANUARY 31: HANOI, VIETNAM

### TOUR: HANOI

Today we explore Hanoi, a city of contrasts, from its colonial French architecture to Vietnamese pagodas, from tranquil green parks to bustling streets. Our tour takes us to the Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum and the small rustic home where he lived his final years. We visit the unique One Pillar Pagoda, which dates from 1049 and the Temple of Literature, dedicated to the cult of Confucius. We also stop at the Hoa Lo Prison, known by its American inmates as the "Hanoi Hilton."

We bid farewell to Hanoi as we begin transfers for homebound flights.

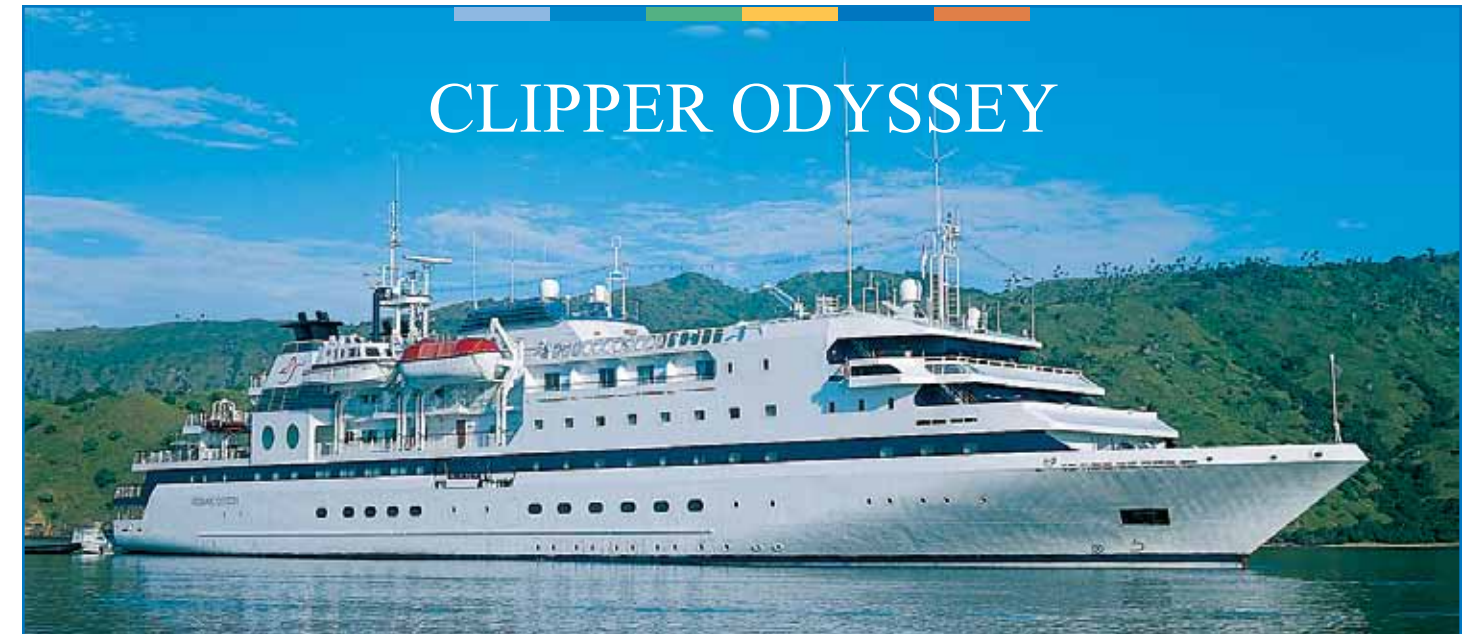
## BANGKOK PRE-TOUR • JANUARY 16–19, 2013

Arrive on January 16 in Bangkok, the vibrant capital city of Thailand. Our centrally located hotel, the five-star Mandarin Oriental, lies on the banks of the Chao Phraya River. From here we are able to explore Bangkok's many attractions, including the Grand Palace and the Temple of the Emerald Buddha. We travel by long-tail boat along the network of canals in Bangkok to discover the unspoiled way of life here. Two rounds of golf are scheduled at the private Thai Country Club and the Suwan Country Club, yearly host of an Asian Tour event.

*The Bangkok Pre-Tour price is \$2,135 per person, double occupancy and includes three nights accommodations, two rounds of golf, breakfasts, tours and airport transfers. Airfare from Bangkok to Siem Reap is not included and should be booked with your international ticket.*

*Clipper Odyssey* is ideally suited for exploring the coastline of Vietnam. This casual expedition vessel accommodates a maximum of 110 passengers. All accommodations have an ocean view, mini refrigerator, individually controlled air-conditioning, flatscreen TV, DVD player, in-room music system and sitting area with sofa. Each bathroom has both a shower and a small bathtub.

*Clipper Odyssey's* cuisine features American meals with pan-Asian specialties also available. This boutique cruise ship offers a warm and inviting atmosphere, thanks in part to its gracious and attentive service staff.

Onboard amenities include a lounge, library, fitness room, outdoor pool, massage room, hair salon, gift shop and Internet café with wireless access. Outdoor space is vast, with a teakwood jogging track and plenty of shaded areas from which to comfortably enjoy the dramatic scenery.
