


DECEMBER 1: QUEENSTOWN, NEW ZEALAND (SOUTH ISLAND)

Plan to arrive in Queenstown on December 1. You will be transferred to the Sofitel Queenstown Hotel and Spa. Relax and explore this delightful town until our welcome reception this evening. If you plan to arrive early in Queenstown, we are happy to make arrangements for additional nights at the Sofitel Queenstown, and help organize private tours of the area, including a helicopter tour or cruise of Milford Sound.

DECEMBER 2: QUEENSTOWN

GOLF: JACK'S POINT

Within a 3,000-acre nature preserve on the shores of Lake Tewa, Jack's Point is a must play in Queenstown. The course's elevation changes offer sweeping lake and alpine vistas with 360-degree mountain views. The thrilling challenge and panoramas provide a fitting introduction to golf on the South Island.

TOUR: AMISFIELD WINERY & ARROWTOWN

Queenstown is one of the fastest growing wine regions in New Zealand. Our Kiwi wine expert is on hand to explain the details of the wine making process while we sample the region's Pinot Noirs, ranked among the world's finest. After lunch, we visit Arrowtown, New Zealand's only living, historic gold rush town.

DECEMBER 3: QUEENSTOWN

GOLF: MILLBROOK RESORT

Set in a natural alpine amphitheater in the shadow of The Remarkables mountain range and located near the former gold mining town of Arrowtown, this alpine links course offers a variety of natural hazards including tussocks, streams and schist stone. Millbrook fully exploits the dramatic terrain with a number of elevated tees, offering breathtaking views and a range of strategic options. Annual host of the New Zealand Open since 2014, Millbrook is a must play in Queenstown.

TOUR: JET BOAT ADVENTURE

We embark on a scenic jet boat experience—an exhilarating ride on Lake Wakatipu and the spectacular Shotover River.

DECEMBER 4: NAPIER (NORTH ISLAND) • CAPE KIDNAPPERS

Today, we transfer by chartered aircraft from Queenstown on the South Island to Napier on the North Island. We check-in to our five-star home for the next three evenings in Hawke's Bay—The Farm at Cape Kidnappers, where the service, atmosphere and scenery are incomparable.

DECEMBER 5: CAPE KIDNAPPERS

GOLF: *CAPE KIDNAPPERS*

Spread over a dramatic landscape, Cape Kidnappers is like no other course in the world. Tom Doak created this prize-winning golf course on land perched 500 feet above Hawke's Bay—a site that “belongs more to heaven than earth.” Doak's brilliant design is best demonstrated by just how naturally many fairways utilize the most scenic parts of the site and yet remain fully playable. Generous fairways give way to challenging approach shots into complex greens.

TOUR: *GANNET COLONY & KIWI TOUR*

Our morning begins with a trip to the splendid Cape Kidnappers gannet colony—the only place in the world to see the nesting place of over 20,000 gannets up close. As we watch these birds fly off the cliffs to dive deep for fish, our local guides explain the preening, dance performances and behaviors we witness. In the afternoon, we explore the area around Cape Kidnappers to find New Zealand's national bird, the kiwi. Semi-secretive and nocturnal, few New Zealanders have seen a kiwi in the wild. Our guides lead us to a kiwi habitat, where we will be able view and hold these unique, flightless birds.

DECEMBER 6: CAPE KIDNAPPERS

GOLF: *CAPE KIDNAPPERS*

Golfers will relish a second round at Cape Kidnappers. No excuses about the prevailing winds today on the par three 6th, a cliff-to-cliff shot, or on the par five 15th hole, otherwise known as “Pirates Plank,” which edges out to a green that hangs 450 feet above the Pacific.

TOUR: *NAPIER AND HAWKE'S BAY WINERY*

After a morning exploring Napier and its famed Art Deco architecture, we travel to Hawke's Bay, the oldest established wine growing region in New Zealand, which is home to many of the country's most famous vineyards. We taste fine wines paired with local specialties for lunch.

GOLF: KAURI CLIFFS

Julian Robertson created this exclusive golf retreat, which catapulted into the world's top 50 just one year after completion. The dazzling sea views at every turn and a series of surprising par threes vie for your attention. Where Cape Kidnappers is demanding in approaching the greens, Kauri Cliffs is demanding off the tee. The back side is the more dramatic with six holes hugging the cliffs.

TOUR: WAITANGI TREATY GROUNDS AND KAURI FARM TOUR

Touring guests visit New Zealand's paramount historic site, the Waitangi Treaty Grounds, where Māori chiefs first signed their accord with the British Crown – the Treaty of Waitangi – New Zealand's founding document. All guests will have the opportunity to join the Kauri Cliffs Farm Manager on a tour of the 6,000 acre working sheep farm.

Today we enjoy a unique cooking workshop in which we learn how to prepare New Zealand cuisine. The dishes demonstrated will be served during a gourmet lunch paired with fine Northland wines.

DECEMBER 10–13, 2022

In addition to golf, there is ample time to explore The Rocks district, tour the Sydney Opera House, get up close and personal with native Australian wildlife at Featherdale Wildlife Park, and enjoy the vibrant and diverse dining scene in this wonderful city.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

COST OF THE TRIP INCLUDES

Accommodations: Accommodation for three nights at the Sofitel Queenstown Hotel, three nights at The Farm at Cape Kidnappers and three nights at The Lodge at Kauri Cliffs.

Meals: Welcome cocktail reception in Queenstown; breakfast each morning, lunch during golf and tours as noted in brochure, all dinners at The Farm at Cape Kidnappers and The Lodge at Kauri Cliffs; evening cocktails; house wines and beer with dinner at The Farm and The Lodge.

Transportation: Airport transfers on scheduled dates and transfers to hotel, golf courses or tours as scheduled. Additional charges may be incurred for airport transfers prior to December 1 or after December 10. Flights from Queenstown to Napier and Napier to Kerikeri are planned to be by chartered aircraft; the aircraft type is to be determined among a Convair 580, ATR or other similarly-sized craft. **Kalos Golf reserves the right to fly commercially on any leg if fewer than 24 guests participate in the tour, or if charter availability is limited.**

Golf: Six rounds of golf—18 holes per course (weather permitting); practice facility; golf carts or pull trolleys. Golf bag handling and advance set-up at each course. All courses listed are planned as of February 22, 2021, but may be altered due to course conditioning, tournament calendar or to enhance the program.

Tours: Comprehensive program of sightseeing tours; expert English-speaking national guides in each port of call; all entrance fees. Tours described may be altered due to circumstances that are unforeseen or beyond our control.

Staff: Kalos Tour Director to handle all logistical arrangements and coordinate golf operations.

Gratuities: All gratuities to porters, hotel staff, drivers, local tour guides and Kalos staff.

INSURANCE

Insurance programs are available at additional cost. An application for trip cancellation and interruption insurance will be mailed with your confirmation. For your protection, travel insurance is strongly recommended.

VISAS

In addition to a valid passport, a visa may also be required for some of our programs. It is your responsibility to check with the appropriate countries for their visa requirements based on your citizenship and to secure the necessary documentation for your trip.

Flight and/or train itineraries are subject to change due to government regulations, weather conditions, and other factors. September 3–October 2, 2022:	65% of tour cost
After October 2, 2022:	100% of tour cost

Above penalties also apply to extensions and independent travel arrangements made by Kalos Golf in conjunction with our program. In addition the \$500 Sydney Extension Tour deposit is non-refundable. Airfare penalties are determined by the individual airlines.

If canceled space is resold prior to the date of departure, an amount equal to the sum received for resale, less \$500 per person, will be refunded.

To access these most precious, out of the way spots, which happen to be home to some of the best golf in the Southern Hemisphere, and to ensure ease of travel for our small group, we charter a Convair 580, ATR or similarly-sized aircraft from Queenstown to Napier and Napier to Kerikeri.*

Our staff manages all of the luggage arrangements, eliminating the hassles of typical air travel, allowing us to maximize our time at some of the best accommodations to be found in this island nation.
